## La Raza de La Playa - The Wet Bats

Guiding philosophy: A sense of motion and movement was emphasized, and structure and form deemphasized. Simplicity allowed for a concentration on spatial elements. The goal was similar to that expressed by Side A of *Low* by Bowie; namely, fragmentary structures that suggested further exploration were embraced. All songs essentially begin at some level of improvisation. For this session, the development process was purposefully halted early in order to allow the core essence of each song to flourish.

Methodology: Only two complete songs were brought to the session. Matt brought "Please Send Us Angels," and Jeff brought "Tio Pete." A number of riffs were developed beforehand, but the initial step in our process was to list possible song titles. Music was then discovered that fit those titles.

All tracks were recorded live by the whole band at The Marguarita Room in LA. Overdubs are denoted \* in the lists below.
